



After Care Programme at Mona Preparatory School

At Mona Preparatory School, all our students are viewed as valued stakeholders. With this in mind, Mona Preparatory School offers a wide array of programmes that can facilitate the development of our students after school hours (***See Activity Sheet***). The goal of our After School Programme is to provide enriching opportunities for our students to be fully engaged after formal contact hours.

Our After Care Programme is a programme that is created mainly for our younger students (**K- Grade 1**) who **MUST** be supervised after school hours while on the school premises.

School dismisses at 1:30 p.m. each day for our K- 1 students and 2:00 p.m. for K-2 to Grade 1. The school gives a grace period for parents and guardians to make their pick-ups at 3:00 p.m. During this period, the students are supervised in their classes.

NB. Wednesdays at MONA PREP. Each Wednesday, School dismisses at 2:00 p.m. to facilitate Staff Development activities. Hence, Wednesday is an exception to the regular extended grace period for pick-up.

After Care begins at 3:00 p.m. The duration of the programme is 3:00 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. This is a paid programme and the contribution for this activity for the academic year 2019/2020 is \$500 per day. This **sum must be paid at the Bursary.**

LOWER SCHOOL STUDENTS INVOLVED IN EXTRA-CURRICULAR PROGRAMMES

Parents and Guardians with children/wards who participate in Extra-Curricular programmes and require the children to be supervised after the activity can subscribe to the **Holding Area Option (one hour programme)**. This programme is designed for lower school students (K-1- Grade 1) and will attract a cost of \$200 for anytime within the hour. If a child requires supervision for more than an hour, that child will be placed in the **After Care Programme** and is expected to pay the full cost (\$500).

As a safety procedure, it **MUST** be understood that all students enrolled in the **LOWER DIVISION** of the School will not be allowed to wander in the school yard after the dismissal period.

We continue to explore creative options each year to ensure that our students, parents and guardians feel a sense of belonging as they became active participants in the ***'Mona Experience'***.
